


# Firewise Assessor Course Announcement



## DESCRIPTION:

This 2-day course is designed for fire professionals and community members interested in evaluating properties from a Firewise perspective. The course will train individuals in fire ecology, fire behavior, property assessment, and fire hazard mitigation tactics for property owners. The first day of the course is classroom based and the second day takes place in the field evaluating properties. Participants will need to come eager to learn and have long pants and closed toe shoes for the field day. Restaurants are limited, bringing a lunch is recommended.
