## Current Fire Activity



June 15, 2016 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

National Preparedness Level: **2**  
Southwest Area: **3**      Arizona Forestry: **3**

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received no lightning strikes in the past 24 hours. Red Flag Warning is in effect today from 11 am through 7 pm this evening for low relative humidity and high winds across portions of northern Arizona including the Coconino and Kaibab Plateaus, Grand Canyon country as well as the city of Flagstaff and vicinity. An area of low pressure across the Pacific Northwest will keep temperatures across the region near normal through tomorrow.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 11 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 5 wildfires in the past 24 hours. Two resources were dispatched to a fire outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


