## Current Fire Activity



June 18, 2016 0800 hrs

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received no lightning strikes in the past 24 hours. Expect breezy and dry conditions today. A high pressure system will bring record heat this weekend into early next week. An Excessive Heat Warning has been issued for Gila, La Paz, Maricopa, Mohave, Pima, Pinal, and portions of Cochise, Greenlee, Graham, Santa Cruz and Yavapai counties.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 11 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 3 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 2 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


