Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received no lightning strikes in the past 24 hours. An Excessive Heat Warning has been issued for Gila, La Paz, Maricopa, Pinal, and portions of Coconino, Cochise, Greenlee, Graham, Mohave, Pima, Santa Cruz and Yavapai counties. A strong ridge of high pressure over the region will result in record heat today and Monday. Moisture will be on the increase early next week which may bring a chance of mainly high based thunderstorms to portions of Arizona.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 2 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 2 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 1 resource was dispatched to a fire outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


