## Current Fire Activity



June 27, 2016 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

Southwest Area: **3**      Arizona Forestry: **3**

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received 2,450 lightning strikes (159 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. High pressure will move north and east of Arizona this week allowing warm temperatures to prevail. An increase in moisture will provide a chance for afternoon showers and thunderstorms for the remainder of the week.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 13 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 6 wildfires in the past 24 hours. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


