Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received no lightning strikes in the past 2 days. A Red Flag Warning is in effect today for Cochise, Pima, Santa Cruz, and portions of Greenlee and Pinal counties. Cooler temperatures are expected Tuesday and Wednesday as a low pressure system moves into the region. Warmer temperatures are expected to prevail late Thursday into the weekend.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 19 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 15 wildfires in the past 7 days. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the last 7 days.


