Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received approximately 600 lightning strikes (320 positive strikes) in the past 2 days. Temperatures will be below normal due to the low pressure system moving into the region tomorrow. Warmer and drier conditions are expected early next week. There is a Red Flag Warning for SE Arizona Friday for strong gusty winds.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 5 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to no wildfires in the past 3 days. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the last 3 days.


