Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 2 lightning strikes (2 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Expect dry weather with continued above normal temperatures today. Increasing moisture can be expected through the weekend with a chance of showers and thunderstorms.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 8 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 6 wildfires in the past 24 hours. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


